Dear Parents/Carers,

We do hope that the children have enjoyed their first three weeks back at school this year and are excited by the different things that have been shared with them. Hopefully, this academic year will not suffer the disruptions of the previous two years and the pupils really get to look forward to lots of new opportunities.

Thank you to all families for their understanding and support regarding the changes that are being brought in to tighten and improve the standards of the school. We appreciate that adapting to change takes time and that it may not always be welcomed with open arms.

We love seeing how smart our pupils look each day, so this letter is another reminder regarding the existing expectations for pupils' uniform, as we are aware that some families may still be unsure. If you have already purchased items, please do not worry, simply replace them in time, but let your class teacher know you are doing this. Class teachers will contact parents if there is a more immediate issue with a pupils' appearance and it is hoped that both home and school can work together to resolve it swiftly so that everyone adheres to the expectations of the school. If any family needs assistance with uniform, please speak to the School Office.

All skirts are to be knee-length. All shirts/blouses are to be tucked in. Pupils will all need to come dressed for PE on the days they have that subject. Pupils should not be wearing jewellery of any kind, except for small, single, plain studded earrings. However, these will need to be removed or taped over prior to all PE/Swimming lessons by the pupils themselves or, more conveniently, removed by parents before attending school on their PE days. No make-up or nail varnish is to be worn.

## **INFANTS:**

School motif maroon sweatshirts/sweatshirt cardigans  
Grey school knee-length skirts or pinafores/Grey or black school trousers  
White blouses/shirts or white polo shirts with or without the school motif  
Grey tights or knee length white or grey socks  
All black school, flat-heeled and closed-toe shoes (no trainers of any description or boots)  
White, grey or black socks

In the Summer Term, but not exclusively, the following can be worn:  
Red/Maroon Gingham dresses or grey/black skirt or grey/black shorts  
White polo shirts with or without school motif

(A change of undergarments would be advisable for our youngest of children in case of accidents)

*Infant P.E. Kit*

Plain white T-Shirt and black shorts (No football shirts or T-shirts emblazoned with logos are allowed)

Black plimsolls/trainers

Tracksuit (plain colours for colder weather)

**JUNIORS:**

Maroon sweatshirt/jumper or cardigan with or without school motif.

White shirt/blouse or polo shirt

Plain grey or black school trousers

Plain grey or black knee-length skirt

All black, flat-heeled and closed-toe shoes (no trainers of any description or boots)

Grey, black or white socks

Grey tights or knee-length white/grey socks

In the Summer Term, but not exclusively, pupils may wear red/maroon Gingham dresses or they may wear grey/black school shorts (no Lycra/cycling/sports shorts)

All children should be provided with an art overall (an old adult size shirt will be suitable).

*Junior P.E. Kit*

Maroon Polo shirt with or without the school motif/Plain white T-Shirt (No football shirts or T-Shirts emblazoned with logos are allowed)

Plain black shorts

Outdoor trainers

Black plimsolls/trainers for indoor P.E.

Tracksuit (plain colours for colder weather)

One-piece swimming costume / swimming trunks (no Bermuda shorts)

A hair band to tie back long hair

All clothing must be named.

We hope this clarifies expectations and once again thank you for your support and understanding.
