#### Palm Sunday

This remembers Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on a donkey, welcomed by people throwing down their cloaks and palm branches, a traditional way of honouring a worthy person.



# Maundy Thursday

Remembering the day of the Last Supper. The disciples met with Jesus to celebrate a Passover meal together.



Recalls the day on which Jesus was tried by Pontius Pilate and eventually crucified on Golgotha Hill.





### Easter Sunday

Celebrates the resurrection of Jesus. When the women went to the empty tomb they found that the body of Jesus had disappeared. Christians believe this shows that Jesus was resurrected.
