## INDUSTRIAL STRIKE ACTION

As you will be aware, the National Education Union (NEU), National Association of Head Teachers (NAHT) and National Association of Schoolmasters Union of Women Teachers (NASUWT) held ballots of their members on industrial action. Following these votes, members of the NEU across England have decided to strike.

We will update you if there is any change.

In this region, strikes will take place across Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023. There are also three additional strikes planned for June and July, but there are no dates confirmed at present. These may have an impact on our Federation of schools.

We will review our ability to open the schools safely in advance of every planned strike day.

**As a result of the strikes on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023, both of our schools will remain open to all pupils as normal.**

Should any future strikes cause a shortage in staffing, we will inform you as to whether certain classes may need to be closed for safety reasons. If classes are closed, pupils must remain at home and will be provided with a programme of home/remote learning, which will be sent via Class Dojo or Google Classroom.

We apologise for any inconvenience, which may be caused by the industrial strike action.
