
The True Story of the Three Little Pigs—We re-wrote our own version of The True Story of Goldilocks and the Tree Bears.

Internet Safety— We have discussed how to be safe on the internet using passwords, secure settings and being careful of the information we share.

P.E./Dance/Games

Dance— We have been experimenting with different ways to use our bodies to a beat to create our own dance moves. Using this, we have been creating our own dance to Ed

Sheeran's Shivers.

Tennis— We learnt some basic rules of a tennis match and played games where we had to prevent the ball from bouncing twice. We learnt different ways to hit the ball and experimented when we would use these. We looked at the underarm tennis serve.

Termly Curriculum Overview

Science

Light— We have learnt that light sources generate light. Investigated which surfaces reflect light and how mirrors work. We have experimented with opaque, translucent and trans-

parent objects, and shadow.

Forces and Magnets— we have learnt that a force is a push or a pull on an object. We have investigated which surfaces have the most friction and why. We learnt about Gravity and Air resistance in guided reading. We also learnt that magnets create their own magnetic field which pulls magnetic objects towards it—experimenting which materials are attracted to a magnet.



History/Geography

Black History Month— We looked at Mary Seacole and Jesse Owens as our main significant individuals and created fact files on these. Some children then researched other Black significant individuals and sports stars.

Stone Age to Iron Age— We have looked closely at the Stone Age through the Palaeolithic to Neolithic periods. We have looked at how tools, houses, gathering food and their clothing developed through the Stone Age to the Bronze Age. We have read about the Iron Age in Guided reading.

The UK— We have learnt about countries, cities, rivers, seas, hills and mountains in the UK using an atlas to identify these.



Mathematics

Addition and Subtraction— we have used a variety of methods to support our understanding including Base 10, pictorial methods and abstract methods. We have used the formal method for both operations and learnt

what to do when we need to exchange. We have looked at the inverse operations as well as word problems.

Multiplication and Division— we have looked at arrays and grouping to support our understanding of multiplication and division and worked on our times-tables. We will continue to work on this after the Christmas break.


French—We have been learning French greetings such as Bonjour and Salut; ways to say goodbye such as A demain and bonne nuit; how to say our name and instructions for the classroom.
