### English

**Poetry**– We will be studying the poem ‘The Highway Man’ and writing a response to it from another point of view.

**Narrative**– We will be writing an adventure story.

**Guided Reading**– We will be reading ‘The Call of the Wild’ this term.

We will be continuing our work on decimals and percentages, shape and space, perimeter, statistics, position and direction, negative numbers, measurement and converting units.
