### English

We will be working on our narrative writing and poetry skills looking at a range of texts including The Last Bear and The colour collector.

#### Guided reading

We will read and discuss short stories and poetry such as Matilda, To the Countryside, Night Sky Dragons and Give and Take.

### Music

We will be analysing songs and what the key features of songs are. We will look at pulse and thinking about what the words mean in a song.

### Art/DT

#### Pneumatics – making a toy monster.

We will use a range of materials to develop and create our own moving monster using a pneumatic mechanism.
