School Song Competition

Some time ago, we entered our school song into a national competition ([Welcome to The School Song - The School Song UK](#)) as another opportunity to broaden the appeal of our wonderful schools. As a result, we have pleasure in informing you that we have been shortlisted for the final to be held on Monday 6th October 2025 at the Radlett Centre, Hertfordshire, WD7 8HL.

There are strict parameters surrounding this competition, one of them being that we are only allowed to take a maximum number of fifteen pupils to perform the school song on stage. Another is that there are to be no parent spectators as there will be too many children from a plethora of schools attending. Mrs. White-Joubert will select the children she feels will best perform the song in the competition.

The winner will get the chance to have their song recorded and there is also prize money to be won for the best three songs. The recording will take place either in the last week of October or the first week of November.

The children will travel by coach with Mrs. White-Joubert and another staff member. The school needs to be at the venue by 11:00am, so the children need to leave the Junior school at the latest 7:50am to allow for any adverse traffic issues and arrive in good time. Children should arrive punctually no earlier than 7:45am. The coach will leave on time due to the length of journey. Once finished, children will leave the venue at 3:00pm, so should return at approximately 6:30pm. Should there be any changes to this return time, staff will use Class Dojo to inform parents.

All children participating must be in correct uniform all with a school-coloured cardigan or jumper. They will also require a packed lunch and plenty of refreshments for the entire journey. As with all trips exemplary behaviour will be expected. Please indicate whether you wish your child to receive a school packed lunch on the slip below.

On this occasion, the cost of the coach is being fully covered by the school.
