Parent Consultation Evenings - Autumn Term 2025

We would like to invite you to discuss your child's work and the progress he/she has made so far this term. Consultations will take place from 3.45pm during the week beginning 20th October 2025.

In an effort to continue to provide more convenience to working parents we are wishing for our Parent-Teacher meetings to remain as either a ten-minute telephone call or a virtual meeting via Google Meet. Teaching staff will, however, be inviting specific families for face-to-face sessions on Tuesday 21st October 2025 at the Junior school and on Thursday 23rd October 2025 at the Infant school where that might be more beneficial for the child. Teaching staff will inform these families directly.

For those who have been invited in for a face-to-face appointment, please go to the main Reception to make staff aware of your arrival. If any parent invited into school would still prefer to have a telephone call or virtual meeting simply inform your class teacher.

Teaching staff from both schools will be sending out a booking link using Google Calendar. This link will be sent out to you via Class Dojo. This format was used last year. Please inform your class teacher if you are unable to do this. We are hoping this approach continues to make things even more efficient, particularly for families with more than one child.

Teachers will also be sending home their termly pupil reports for your perusal in advance of any parent-teacher meetings.

After half-term, our SENDCOs will be offering additional meetings with the parents of children with SEND should they be requested. We ask that parents inform the class teachers at the initial parent-teacher meetings whether they would like this to be arranged. The SENDCOs will then contact parents directly. Nearer the end of term, we will again be hosting a Curriculum Celebration Event, where you will be invited in to go through your child's books and learning journey alongside them.
